



WARNINGS AND PRECAUTIONS



IMPORTANT:

PLEASE READ AND FULLY UNDERSTAND ALL WARNINGS AND PRECAUTIONS PRIOR TO USING KREEP-UP™ PRODUCT. FOLLOW ALL PRODUCT ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS, STATEMENTS AND WARNINGS PROVIDED. FAILURE TO READ AND FOLLOW ALL WARNINGS, PRECAUTIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS PROVIDED MAY RESULT IN MISUSE OF PRODUCT, LEADING TO INJURY OR DEATH BY USER OR OTHERS.

INTENDED USE OF KREEP-UP™ PRODUCT:

Kreep-Up™ is intended to be an aid for mechanics and automotive enthusiasts, allowing easier access to service and maintain automobile engines and components where access through the hood of the vehicle is required. Kreep-Up™ is designed to slide under the vehicle and over the fenders or bumpers to allow the User a safe, extended reach and greater mobility, while keeping the User and tools off the delicate paint finish of the vehicle. Kreep-Up™ should not be used:

- For any activity other than its intended use.
- As a ladder, step stool or other device meant for reaching overhead.
- By more than one person at a time.
- By any person exceeding 400 lbs.
- As a vehicle jack or brace for any equipment, parts or devices.

PRIOR TO USING KREEP-UP™ PRODUCT:

- Be sure ground where Kreep-Up™ and vehicle will be placed is dry, flat and free of debris, grease, oil or any other items that may pose a hazard during the use of Kreep-Up™.
- Do not use Kreep-Up™ in a high traffic area such as streets, drive aisles, parking lanes, parking lots, etc. Area of use should be dedicated to safely servicing vehicles only and vehicle driving traffic should be limited to only limited movement of other vehicles by qualified, observant mechanics (i.e. a service shop or garage).
- Be sure Kreep-Up™ unit is dry, and free of debris, grease, oil or any other items that may pose a slip or fall hazard during the use of Kreep-Up™.
- Verify all fasteners, locking pins and parts on Kreep-Up™ are in place and properly tightened prior to use.
- Consult the vehicle user's manual for cautions, warnings and guidelines on that specific vehicle's equipment and components.

PROPER USE OF KREEP-UP™ PRODUCT:

- Do not use Kreep-Up™ as a grounding device for welding equipment, batteries or any other electrical device as it may pose a shock hazard to the User or others nearby.
- Keep arms, hands, clothing, hair, jewelry and tools away from moving vehicle parts, such as fans, belts, intakes, etc.
- Avoid distractions while using Kreep-Up™.
- Use only in properly lit environments with lighting adequate to performing the task at hand.
- Do not use Kreep-Up™ if under the influence of alcohol, drugs or prescription medication that may inhibit your ability to reason, maintain balance or operate machinery.
- Do not use Kreep-Up™ in standing water, on wet pavement or on areas that may pose a slip or fall hazard.
- Do not place shims, boards or other leveling products under Kreep-Up™. If work surface is deemed to not be flat, re-locate to a suitable location. Do not use Kreep-Up™ on sloped or uneven surfaces.
- Do not use Kreep-Up™ or place Kreep-Up™ under a vehicle lift of any sort.
- If damaged parts or missing parts are noticed prior to use, do not use Kreep-Up™. Contact Kreep-Up™ for replacement parts and fully complete required repairs prior to use.
- Do not sit or stand on chest pad of Kreep-Up™.
- Always face forward on Kreep-Up™. Do not step up or down in a backwards position.
- Do not carry items while on Kreep-Up™ that may cause you to lose balance or fall.
- Do not alter Kreep-Up™ in any form. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - Attaching non-authorized items such as hooks, bins, tools that may alter structural integrity of Kreep-Up™
 - Drilling holes in posts or other components
 - Removing parts not intended for removal (posts, feet, wheels, fasteners, etc.)
- Do not use corrosive chemicals or abrasives on Kreep-Up™. Standard automotive cleaners and de-greasers may be used to clean metal and vinyl portions of product.
